In Maths, we linked the theme to pattern making, with the children completing and creating their own patterns inspired by the story. In English, we focused on early writing skills, including labelling our drawings and creating story maps to bring the tale to life.

We also took our learning outdoors, where the children worked in groups to collect sticks for building miniature houses. They experimented with construction techniques and developed important teamwork skills as they competed to see which group could gather the most sticks.

School Uniform Reminder

- Any clothes or footwear that the children wear should be suitable for a day at school, skirts should be standard school skirt length, no heels, no jewellery.
- No make-up, false eyelashes or eyebrows, no nail varnish or jewellery, hair accessories should be small and plain coloured.
- Shoes must be sensible, plain black shoes, no open toes, no heels.

- 3. **School-Sanctioned Photos and Videos**: At certain events, the school may arrange for official photos or videos to be taken by staff. These recordings will adhere to safeguarding policies, and any images shared by the school will only include students with prior parental consent.

Your cooperation with these guidelines helps us to maintain a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all children.
