







Year Five Family Learning Project - Autumn 2

Remember your speech marks, reported clause and relevant punctuation.	Discuss what life would have been like during ancient Greek times. Discuss any differences and similarities to your life today. CHALLENGE! Record your discussion in any way you like - voice recording, written interview form, poster, PowerPoint.	Create a Trojan horse out of recyclable materials.  CHALLENGE! Can you find a way to make your horse move? Think carefully about how you will attach the wheels.	Teach someone at home your Greek dance you have been learning. CHALLENGE! Can you create a new set of 8 counts to teach them?	Visit Ayot Green New St Lawerance Church which is said to be modelled on the columns found in the temple to Apollo on the island of Delos  CHALLENGE! Does the architecture remind you of any other point in history? Explain what similarities and difference you notice.	Investigate the Greeks' presence in Britain. What can you find out about when they arrived and what they did? CHALLENGE! What can you find out about Pytheas and his travels to Britain?
