All landscapes and environments offer opportunities, constraints and, sometimes, risks and hazards to the people who coexist with them. This enquiry exemplifies this in a manner that is straightforward for pupils to grasp and to evaluate. As the enquiry evolves, so pupils are able to appreciate how environments may change over time and how this might bring advantages and challenges to the people who are interconnected with them. Science Focus:	Saxon invasions, settlements and kingdoms and Anglo-Saxon art and culture. Science Focus:	Through the experiences of these individuals and communities, pupils are able to reflect upon how changes to normal and usual weather conditions can have to serious implications for these people. They are also able to appreciate that, generally speaking, the poorer the people and communities are that experience changes in weather patterns, the more serious the impact often is. From these specific case studies the pupils are encouraged to look at the concept of global warming, what is contributing to it on a global scale and to generalise about climate change in the longer term. The enquiry culminates in pupils understanding the action that is being taken during this century across the world to reduce fossil fuel consumption (and therefore carbon dioxide emissions) through the development of renewable sources of energy.
