We will be using Jigsaw to support with our personal, social, health and emotional wellbeing.



Year 4

English

Within our English lessons, we will be using the text 'Rosie Revere, Engineer' by Andrea Beaty as our focus text. We will be developing our inference skills to think about character and setting. Maths

With all our work, we will constantly be looking to reason and problem solve.




Learning Adventure

Our learning adventure this half term will be the Romans.
