**What Was It Like Living In Victorian Times?**

## English

Within our English lessons, we will be using the text 'Africa Amazing Africa' by Antinuke as our focus text.

We will be developing our inference skills to think about character and plot. We will be writing a range of descriptions, developing our use of vocabulary, punctuation and sentence structures. We will also be working on our audience awareness.



## Learning Adventure

Our learning adventure this half term will be learning about what life was like in England during Victorian times.

We will begin our topic by finding out when the Victorian era was in relation to other historical events. We will move on to learning about life for Victorian children, life in the workhouse and Victorian school.

We will be using the texts Street Child and Oliver Twist to support our learning.

## Computing

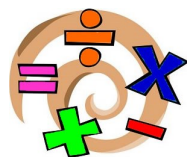
We will be exploring how to code and programme.



## Maths

We will start our half term in Maths by learning about place value up to 10,000,000. Following that, we are going to be learning about rounding and choosing efficient methods for addition and subtraction.

Later on in the half term we will move on to developing strategies for multiplication and division and solving calculation problems with all four operations.



## Science

In our science work we will be exploring light. Firstly, we will recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines. We will then explore how we can see objects out of the human eye. Finally, moving onto why shadows have the shape as the objects that cast them.



## Religious Education

We will be using Discovery RE and be learning about the idea of belonging as a theme across different religions.



## Physical Education

We will continue to have two weekly PE lessons this half term on Wednesday and Thursday afternoon. We will also be swimming on a Tuesday Morning.
