Learning Adventure

We starting our new History topic on Kings and Queens. Our enquiry question is 'Who was the most powerful British Monarch?'

In this unit, pupils are introduced to monarchs chronologically—in their dynasties—to help gain a good understanding of Britain's ruling past, from 1066. We will look at each dynasty—from the Normans to the present day Windsors.

Significant monarchs are studied within each dynasty. As we work our way through, we will consider how each monarch has battled for power in some way and the impacts they have had on society.
