

Learning Adventure

Our learning adventure this half term will be 'What would life have been like as an Egyptian?'

The unit begins with an overview of where Egypt is and when the Ancient Egyptian civilisation was. It focuses on the Old, Middle, and New Kingdoms as the main periods of Ancient Egyptian history. Pupils begin a timeline that they will continue to add to throughout the unit.

Children to learn about the achievements of the earliest civilisations through the context of the Ancient Egyptians. Children then learn about the life and times of the Egyptians, including art, religion, culture, entertainment and the rules and laws of Egyptian society.



Science

In science we will be exploring the topic 'Forces and Magnets'. We will look at the main forces that exist, complete an experiment investigating friction and use magnets to find out which materials are magnetic.

Values / SMSC

This term we will be looking at our 'Dreams and Goals' in PSHE.

We will use the Jigsaw platform to explore the challenges that people face and to think about how to meet and overcome new challenges in our lives.

Art

In Art this term, we will be exploring the topic of 'Shape and Colour'. We will learn about Henri Matisse and use his work 'The Snail' to inspire us to make our own collages using bold shapes and colours.



Computing

This term we will be using Purple Mash to learn about email and branching databases. We will also be learning about how to keep ourselves safer when online.

English

Within our English lessons, we will be using the text 'Mini Rabbit, Not Lost' to create our own adventure story based on the events in the book.

We will also be writing persuasive letters, reports and diary entries throughout the term

Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be developing our knowledge on the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 multiplication and division facts.

With all our work, we will constantly be looking to reason and problem solve.

Religious Education

In R.E we will investigate the question, 'Who is god to the Sikhs?'

We will learn about the life of Guru Nanak and find out what the three most important Sikh beliefs are.

Physical Education

We will have weekly PE lessons this half term on Monday and Friday. In indoor PE of Fridays we will create dances inspired by the weather whilst on Mondays we will learn to play Tag Rugby outdoors.
